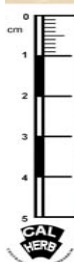

branches of a tree overhanging the stream

DESCRIPTION : Epiphyte, clamping slender branches.
Lvs. fleshy, bifarious; inflorescence with a
long petiole & a glomer. glomer. saucerlike, creamy
white, purple dotted; spur transversely
protruding, prominent
