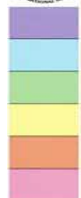
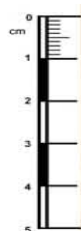

Wendlandia glabrata DC. - a new form
from a good many of the
localities above.
The leaves are small but 3
to 4 inches long, the
flowers are yellow, it
is a tree.
The plant is not like any
example in the Calcutta Herbarium
of either of the two species of
the tree, of which it has
character. It may possibly
be related to the tree
on which the plant is
collected. The plant is
very small, but not as
small as the tree on which
it was collected.
